Commissioner Lonneville called the meeting to order at 3:00PM

The minutes of April 21st prepared by the Recording Clerk and upon reviewing the minutes a motion was made by Mayor Mink, seconded by Trustee Buttaccio voted upon and unanimously carried, as prepared and place on file.

Treasurer Gurewitch presented the April operation and Maintenance Treasurers Report, a motion was made by Trustee Buttaccio seconded by Trustee Henry voted upon and unanimously carried, as prepared and place on file.

## Gordon Eddington Report:

- 1. Ran Belt press/composting solids
- 2. Residents are taking compost on a regular basis
- 3. Ordered surge protection device for main pump station VFD's
- 4. Friendly Village Park had a sewer backup on Sunday May 3<sup>rd</sup>. We were called out to investigate if problem was being caused by our pump station. I met Bill DeVinny and we pulled the trash rack at the station to see if it was causing a backup. This was not the problem. Checked the manholes in the park and found several that were backed up. Determined that the problem was a plugged sewer main in the park. Park officials contacted a contractor to dig and repair problem.
- 5. Bill is on sick leave until sometime in June.
- 6. Annual testing of RPZ (backflow prevention) units was completed. Units at main plant as well as pump stations tested OK. We are in the process of replacing test cocks and a faulty valve on one of the units at the main plant.
- 7. Routine operation and maintenance.

Gordon will get more information and pricing on a Sewer Cleaning Machine, plus financing optionsl available.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:26 p.m. on motion by Mayor Mink and seconded by Trustee Trimm.
