- 1. Ran belt press-Composting Sludge
- 2. NYSDEC inspected our sludge handling and composting operation on June 26th inspection went well
- 3. Installed rebuilt pump at main pump station after rebuild
- 4. Main plant flow calibrated.
- 5. Mechanical bar screen motor and controller failed-called in service rep. Purchased motor to temporally get unit back online while waiting for new motor and controller-(3-week delivery time)
- 6. Replace 2 clarifier water recirculating pumps
- 7. Flows are low-typical for this time of year
- Ran trial on "Wart Hog" sewer jet cleaner head. Works really well on roots and grease build up in sewer lines. Both Manchester and Shortsville recommend we purchase it @\$1500.
- 9. Maintenance on equipment-everything is running fine.
