Sign up for reverse 911 alerts from the Village of Shortsville and Ontario County
The reverse 911 system can be used to alert you to emergencies in your neighborhood including utility interruptions (water, electricity or gas) road closures, missing persons and more. The system is activated by the county 911 center approved by Village Officials including the Mayor, Fire Chief or Chief of Police for the Village of Shortsville residents.
